### Gospel Reflection

Put yourself in this scene. You are in a small sailboat with the apostles. A great storm comes up and the waves crash against the boat. Jesus, who must be very tired, stays asleep. The apostles, afraid of drowning, wake Jesus up. "Be still," he tells the storm at sea, and at once there is a great calm. His disciples' mood switches from terror to awe at this sign, which recalls so vividly the words of God in the first reading.

Let us imagine that Jesus asks us, as he asked the disciples, "Why are you lacking in faith?" How will we answer? What is Jesus trying to show us in this event? No matter what happens in life, we can turn to Jesus who helps us and brings us peace. How will you bring his peace to others?
